

MUNICIPAL SCHOLARSHIP GRANT GUIDELINES SY 2021-2022
(For High School Education)
MANGALDAN, PANGASINAN

A. THE SCHOLARSHIP OFFERING:

1. **General Description** – The scholarship consists of financial aid from the Local Government of Mangaldan for the public secondary education of poor but deserving incoming Grade 7 students from the general fund (Gender and Development (GAD) of the Municipality;
2. **Financial Aid**, what it consists of - The amount of **Twelve Thousand Pesos (P12,000.00)** shall be given annually as financial aid to the scholar for transportation and miscellaneous allowances. The amount of **P1,200.00** shall be withdrawn by the scholar on a monthly basis for **Ten (10) months** from the Office of the Mayor at the scheduled date and time excluding summer vacation;
3. **Standard for maintaining scholarship benefits** – Every scholar must maintain a general weighted average of not lower than 85% or its equivalent in all subjects. Failure to meet the foregoing standard set will automatically disqualify for the scholarship benefit for the ensuing year provided that in the following year he/she meets the standard set, he/she will be granted again the same scholarship benefits. **Exception for the average grade requirement of 85% is for graduating scholars only who might be re-accepted on valid grounds which has to be determined by the Municipal Scholarship Committee.**
4. **Effect of other scholarships** - The scholar who is able to earn academic scholarship or some other kind of educational benefits or privileges from the school itself or other sources (i.e. Scholarship grants of private organization) will be given an option to select what scholarship he/she will avail. His/her option shall be made within five (5) days from receipt of notice of admission as municipal scholar. In case he/she waives the municipal scholarship, the next highest ranking applicant shall take the scholarship slot.

B. THE SELECTION CRITERIA

1. **Application forms** shall be duly-accomplished and submitted to the Office of the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator (OMPDC).
2. **The qualified applicant** shall secure Certificate of Indigency from his/her Barangay.

The Municipal Scholarship Committee reserves the right to disqualify applicants recommended by the School Principal with notice thereof prior to the date of examination if he/she does not meet the standards set regarding indigency family income.

Family Income Standard – The qualifier or candidate for scholarship must belong to a family with a Gross Monthly Family Income of **Twenty Thousand Pesos (P20,000.00)** or less.

- a. A **PER CAPITA** income distribution assumes that the bigger the family the bigger are the expenditures and, consequently, the smaller the income distribution become.
- b. Income shall consist of the traditional sources, including support from kin and a yearly fixed valuation of certain properties/assets that provide financial support where such are not declared.
- c. Family consist of all legal dependents as defined by our income tax laws as well as dependent descendants and dependent brothers and sisters of the husband or wife actually living with the family.

C. DATE AND PLACE OF EXAMINATION

The Municipal Scholarship Committee shall give the scholarship examination to all qualified applicants. **The EXAM will be on AUGUST 12, 2021 at the 3rd Floor, Mangaldan Municipal Building. The exam shall start at 8:00 A.M. and shall end at 11:00 A.M.**

D. SCOPE OF THE EXAMINATION - The test shall consist of three (3) parts which is divided as indicated in the following table:

PART OF THE TEST	ITEM SEQUENCE	TIME ALLOCATED
I. Mathematical Ability	1- 50	1 Hour
II. English Proficiency	51- 100	1 Hour
III. Scientific Ability	101-150	1 Hour

The test shall be checked immediately by the members of the checking committee assigned by the chairman of the Municipal Scholarship Committee and the results shall be posted/announced by the chairman of the Municipal Scholarship Committee on **August 20, 2021** in front of the Municipal Building, and the Public Information Office, Mangaldan, Pangasinan.

In case of tie, another set of questions shall be given to break the tie in qualifying examination.
